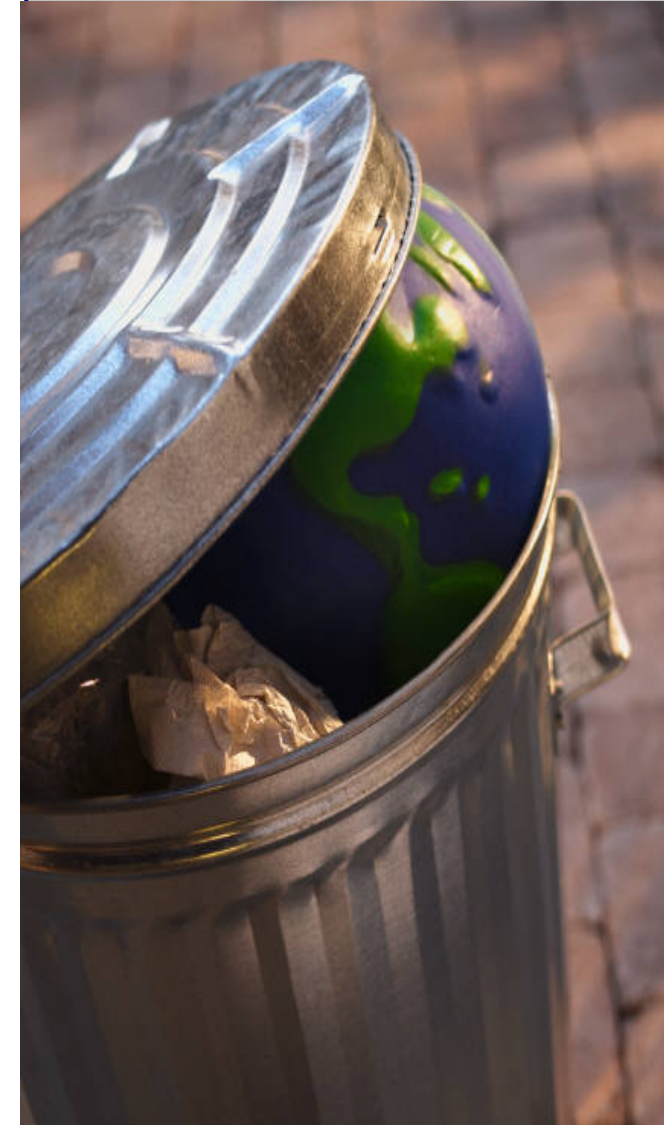

## **Non-assessed residents recycling center permit**

Residents living in incorporated cities and towns and outside the county also have an opportunity to use the recycling centers with purchase of an annual permit. Permits cost \$100 each year, and are transferrable to a maximum of three registered vehicles per household. Applications with required documentation should be brought to the Solid Waste administration office (5601 SE 66th St., Ocala). Check, cash and credit cards are accepted. Applications will be processed on site and permit will be issued once all is verified.

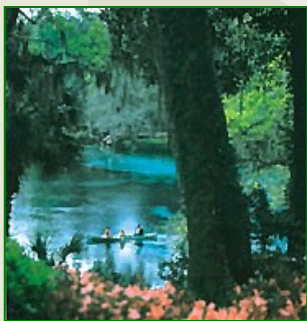

Household Garbage and Yard Waste  
are picked up **Mondays and  
Thursdays.**

(Next day after certain holidays\*)

Holiday for garbage pick-up is the actual legal day of the holiday.  
Not necessarily the day the city observes the holiday and admin  
offices closed.

Household garbage and recycling are now  
co-mingled. **Please separate your  
yard waste and place next to household  
garbage.** Weight Not to Exceed 50 lbs.

**ALL ITEMS MUST BE  
CURBSIDE BY 7:00 A.M.**

**Special Pick Up Rates**

Bulk Yard Waste *	\$ 12.93	per cubic yard*
Oversized household Furniture, ie.Sleep sofa	\$ 16.17	per item
White Goods	\$ 16.17	Per item
Construction Debris: Contact Waste Management for dumpster and cost or go to your local home improvement store and purchase a bagster (instructions included with purchase).		
* Two (2) cubic yard limit per collection included. This charge is for yard waste in excess of two (2) yards to be picked up at one time and billed to you. You must call City Hall and authorize prior to collection.

**SPECIAL PICK UP SERVICES**

*The City of Dunnellon offers special pick up  
service for household goods, appliances and  
bulk yard waste. Please call  
352-465-8500 opt. 4 to arrange for service  
and fees. The fees will be charged to your  
regular monthly utility bill.*

**\*YARD WASTE**

*Requirements for picking up yard waste are  
that loose debris(leaves, etc.) be contained  
(bagged, canned, etc.) not to exceed 50 lbs.,  
limbs no longer than 4' (four feet,) and 6"  
(six inches) in diameter. Do not build up  
large piles.*

*Maximum pick up is 2 yards per visit.*

**SET UP REGULAR SERVICE**

*To set up regular trash pick-up service, you  
must have a water account with FGUA.*
