RESOLUTION #RES2023-19

- A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DUNNELLON COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY; ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF DUNNELLON COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF PRIOR INCONSISTENT RESOLUTIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
- WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Dunnellon, Florida adopted Ordinance No. 2000-03 creating the City of Dunnellon Community Redevelopment Agency ("CRA") pursuant to Part III, Chapter 163, Florida Statutes; and
- WHEREAS, the CRA is a dependent special district under Chapter 189, Florida Statutes, known as the Uniform Special District Accountability Act of 1989 ("Act"); and
- WHEREAS, the Act requires all special districts, including dependent special districts such as the CRA, to adopt a budget for each fiscal year by resolution; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Dunnellon Community Redevelopment Agency desires to comply with the requirement of the Act and takes this action in order to do so;
- **Section 1. Recitals.** The foregoing recitals are deemed true and correct and are hereby fully incorporated herein by this reference and are deemed a material part of this Resolution.
- Section 2. Adoption of the Budget. The Board Members of the City of Dunnellon Community Redevelopment Agency do hereby approve and adopt a budget attached hereto as Exhibit "A" for the CRA for Fiscal Year 2023-2024; beginning October 1, 2023 and ending September 30, 2024.
- <u>Section 3.</u> Repeal of Prior Inconsistent Resolutions. All prior resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.
- <u>Section 4.</u> Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this resolution is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion hereto.
- <u>Section 5.</u> Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption by the Board Members of the City of Dunnellon Community Redevelopment Agency.
