Non-assessed residents recycling center permit

Check, cash and credit cards are accepted. Applications will be processed on site and permit will be issued once all is verified.

*Two (2) cubic yards per collection are included with regular service. This charge is for yard waste in excess of normal service limits and billed to you. You must call City Hall for prior authorization.

SPECIAL PICK UP SERVICES

The City of Dunnellon offers special pick up service for household goods, appliances and bulk yard waste. To arrange for service please call 352-465-8500. The fees will be charged to your regular monthly utility bill.

*YARD WASTE

Loose debris (leaves, etc.) is required to be contained (bagged, canned, etc.) and not to exceed 50 lbs. Limbs no longer than 4' (four feet) and 6" (six inches) in diameter are allowed. <u>Do not build</u> up large piles.

Maximum pick up is 2 yards per visit.

SET UP REGULAR SERVICE

To set up regular trash pick-up service, you must have a water account with FGUA.
